

### City's Population is Increased by Council

#### Annexation Ordinance Passed 8 to 3.

By a vote of 8 to 3, with two members absent, the City Council in special session Monday night adopted the annexation ordinance annexing additional territory to the city. The passage of the ordinance was preceded by a vote of the Muncie Press.

Councilmen Borjagin, Chappell and Merchallman cast the dissenting vote, while Muller and Adams were absent. There was no discussion of the ordinance.

The next step in the proceedings of the ordinance is to refer the annexed district, and who have not been included in the ordinance, to the Board of Public Works, who will probably be an appeal to the Circuit or the Superior Court.

**Legal Rights Reserved.**

The ordinance was passed by attorneys present at the council chamber before the ordinance as to whether it is valid, in accordance with the rights in remitting. The ordinance has a limited time in which to file their appeal to the courts.

**Preparation of Ordinance.**

It is estimated that the annexation brings into the city over 1,000 people and increases the assessed value of property about \$100,000.

An estimate of the cost of the area brought in by the ordinance as annexed was furnished.

The citizens living in the newly annexed portions will be permitted to vote at the coming election. They will not have to pay taxes on the property until the ordinance is passed.

It will be three weeks before there are any changes in valuation matters as the Department of Finance will have to re-assess the value of the property in the newly annexed territory.

**When the introduction of the ordinance was made, the council of the city was in session and the ordinance was read. The ordinance was then referred to the Board of Public Works, who will probably be an appeal to the Circuit or the Superior Court.**
