In 1927, famous 'Diamond Heels Hattie' B. Anthony donated (sold for \$1) this land to develop the largest subdivision bordering Wheeling Avenue since the 1800's. This is another example of the Anthony family's contributions to Muncie's growth since pioneer days.

In 2019, Muncie will begin widening Wheeling Avenue and this stone gateway entrance sits in the path. INDOT does not recognize it as historic and will not help save it.

Please stop by this intersection any hour on Sat 11/2 after 9am to help us store its stones until hopefully there will be some right of way and funding to rebuild it after Wheeling has been widened.
